Genesee River Ride

Generally, the Genesee River Ride follows the closest route to the Genesee River. The only exception is when the route follows the El Camino Trail. As such, the ride is either north or south except when it crosses the river. Most of the ride is on trails and some bike lanes. Sections through Downtown are on city streets. Be careful of tree roots and other hazards on trails.

1st Section – To River and north to Maplewood Park by Kodak

- East Avenue, Main St to North Fitzhugh Street
- Right on North Fitzhugh, Right on Allen Street
- Left on State Street, Right on Commercial Street
- Left on Browns Race, left on Platt St., right on Mill St. to Genesee Riverway Trail
- Right on Smith Street over <u>Smith Street Bridge</u>. Left on St Paul St.
- St, Paul (bike lane) north to Brewer Street
- Left on Brewer Street to Genesee Riverway Trail
- Genesee Riverway Trail over Middle Falls Bridge
- Genesee Riverway Trail across Diving Park to Maplewood Park by Kodak

2nd Section – North to Charlotte and back to Maplewood Park by Kodak


- Riverway Trail and road to Lake Avenue
- Lake Avenue bike lane past cemetery to Riverway Trail
- Riverway Trail to Charlotte and end of pier
- Reverse route to Maplewood Park by Kodak

3rd section -South to Genesee Valley Park

- Cross <u>bridge</u> over Genesee River toward Seneca Park Zoo
- Genesee Riverway Trail south along Zoo Road
- Cross St. Paul St. and continue on Collingsworth Drive to El Camino Trail
- El Camino Trail South to Scrantom St. (note jog at Norton St.)
- Right on Strantom St. to St Paul St
- St. Paul St. south to South Ave. and Court St. Right on Court St (Dinosaur BBQ)
- Cross river at Court St. Bridge to Genesee Riverway Trail
- Left on Genesee Riverway Trail south past Genesee Waterways Center to bridge
- Cross pedestrian bridge over Genesee to Genesee Riverway Trail on east side

4th section North from Genesee Valley Park, back to PathStone

- Genesee Riverway north to Woodbury Blvd (just past Skate Park)
- Cross South Ave at Woodbury Blvd
- Woodbury Blvd. past Strong Museum and Adventure Place to S. Union St.
- Left on S. Union St. Bike path to East Ave
- Right on East Avenue back to PathStone



1st Section-Blue - **North**PathStone to Maplewood
Park by Kodak

2nd Section - Red – **North**Maplewood Park by Kodak
to Charlotte and return **South** to Maplewood Park.
Trail not marked once at
Charlotte, nor south from
Charlotte except where
bike path moves to west
side of Lake Ave.

3rd Section - Brown- **South** from Maplewood/Seneca Park through Downtown to Genesee Valley Park

4th Section - Green –**North** Genesee Valley Park back to PathStone

Pink -Route goes two ways along St. Paul Blvd and East Ave.
